Marathon County Youth Hockey
Policy on Rostering Players

Marathon County Youth Hockey Policy effective 2006-07 season.

Crossover double rostering on both youth (boys) and girls teams is not allowed.

YOUTH BOYS PROGRAM

- A. Boys must play at their designated age level in the youth (boys) program.
 - 1. If a tryout is required for player placement and team selection at the players designated level, the player must attend the regularly scheduled association tryout. (See related Policies regarding Player Selection and Team Selection)

GIRLS PROGRAM

- B. Girls are allowed to choose to participate on either the youth (boys) **or** the girls program but not both.
 - 1. If a girl player desires to tryout and play for the youth (boys) program they must contact the Vice President of Player Development or the Tryout Coordinator by a designated DECLARATION DATE prior to the beginning of association tryouts and declare their intent to tryout and play on a boys team.
 - 2. The DECLARATION DATE will be the deadline for girls to declare their intention to tryout for the boys program. The Declaration Date will be posted on the preseason ice schedule. The Declaration Date is to be set during the preseason ice activities no later than 2 days prior to tryouts.

After a girl player declares their intent to tryout for the youth boys program **and** the youth (boys) tryout begins they will not be allowed to change programs. The girl will play on their designated youth boys team resulting from their tryout placement for the duration of the season.

The burden of declaring the girl players intent to try out for the youth (boys) program will be with the player and players parents. A girl who does not declare to tryout for the youth (boys) team or neglects to declare their tryout intentions by the DECLARATION DATE will automatically play in the girls program.

If a tryout is required for player placement and team selection at the players designated level in the girls program, the player must attend any girls tryout that is scheduled. (See related Policies regarding Player Selection and Team Selection)
