

## POLICY REGARDING SERVING OF GAME SUSPENSION

### INTRODUCTION

Players must be suspended for one game under Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association and USA Hockey rules if they are issued a game or match misconduct. If that occurs, the player is obligated to sit out the remainder of the game in which the game misconduct penalty is issued and the next succeeding game played by the team.

In addition, a player may be required to sit out a game by the Discipline Committee of the Association if a player is required to report to the Discipline Committee for more than three ten minute misconduct penalties issued to a player during the season.

### POLICY

If a player is required to sit out a game/match misconduct penalty or penalty imposed by the Discipline Committee, the player shall be required to serve the game suspension by being in attendance at the next successive game played by the team and sitting on the team bench (with helmet) throughout the entire game. This rule shall apply to any instance where a player has been suspended from a game due to disciplinary/misconduct by the individual player. A player who suffers an injury that does not allow the player to play in a game is not required to sit on the player bench (but may do so).
