HOCKEY PLAYER RULES

The Marathon County Youth Hockey Association is dedicated to the development of hockey skills and attitudes of area youth for the purpose of fielding competitive teams and to benefit our Wausau high school programs. We expect our players to strive to the highest standards of playing skills and conduct both on and off the field.

Consistent with this purpose:

Youth hockey players will work hard to improve their skills, be a team player, get along with your teammates, learn teamwork, sportsmanship and discipline, be on time for games and practices, learn the rules and play by them, always be a good sport, respect your coach, your teammates, your parents, opponents and officials, and never argue with an official's decision.

Youth hockey players **will** respect coaches, officials, spectators, teammates and opponents regardless of race, color, religion, age, sex, or national origin.

Youth hockey players **will not** use profanity on the ice, the bench or anywhere else in MP1 and MP2 or at any hockey arena.

Youth hockey players **will not** use tobacco products, consume alcohol or intoxicating beverages, use illegal drugs or controlled substances.

Youth hockey players should remember they are representing Marathon County Youth Hockey Association at all home and away games, hockey camps, tournaments, fund raisers and other hockey activities.

Youth hockey players **will** respect their equipment and uniforms by keeping them clean and in good repair. Youth hockey players will be financially responsible for damage to equipment and uniforms.

Youth hockey players who receive three (3) checking from behind penalties, any 10 minute misconduct penalty other than their first, a game misconduct, a gross misconduct or a match penalty under WAHA or USA Hockey rules will meet with the Discipline Committee. The player's coach and at least one parent will also attend this meeting.

Youth hockey players that are ineligible to play sports under the player athletic Code of Conduct and/or Rules and/or School District Athletic and Academic Policy **will not** participate with MCYHA without the approval of the Board of Directors.

MINIMUM DRESS: MINIMUM DRESS IN LOCKER ROOM FOR ALL SKATERS IS T-SHIRTS/SHORTS. All players shall be allowed reasonable time to dress away from team and there shall be a reasonable time frame to assemble prior to game time (Chalk talks and pre-game talks).
