Marathon County Hockey extends its ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY to all local motels and hotels in which participating teams are staying. Any behavioral problems at motels and hotels will be reported by the affected innkeepers to the Tournament Director. Misbehavior and/or refusals to abide by the innkeepers rules will result in the team being dismissed pursuant to this directive and will forfeit all awards, trophies to which its members would have otherwise been entitled. We have attached a copy of the Central Wisconsin Innkeepers tournament policies. Please distribute a copy to all of your team members. Thank you for your support in treating your local accommodations as you would your own home.

Central Wisconsin Innkeepers Tournament Policies

Welcome coaches, participants and fans! The Central Wisconsin Innkeepers want you, your family and friends to enjoy visiting the Wausau area. With you safety in mind, and the safety of all guests and hotel staff, all area hotels and motels have established the following tournament guidelines:

1. Sporting equipment (sticks, pucks, balls) is not allowed in the hotel/motel at any time unless otherwise posted. Jerseys, pads and other related uniform apparel may be allowed in hotel rooms.
2. Hotel facilities are for registered guests only. There must be a minimum of one adult registered per room who assumes responsibility for any damage. Properties reserve the right to set occupancy maximums per room and may charge for guests over that maximum.
3. The hallways, elevators, lobby, stairwells and fire exits are intended for accessibility only. To prevent disturbing other guests and provide a safe environment for all on property, roughhousing and game playing are not permitted in these areas.
4. For the safety and well being of your child, please do not leave him/her alone in the hotel, even in you guest room. Hotel staff will not provide supervision.
5. Coolers and food brought into the hotel by tournament guests must remain in guest rooms.
6. Please see rules posted in pool area. All pool regulations will be enforced.
7. Quiet times begin at 10:00pm unless otherwise posted. Children are expected in their rooms with the doors tightly closed by 11:00pm. To prevent disturbing those around you, noise must be kept to a minimum beginning at 10:00pm.
8. Many hotels offer pay-per-view movies and Nintendo ®. Rental fees will be posted to a guests account when ordered and will not be refunded or adjusted.
Please check with the front desk to restrict access to pay-per-view.
9. Checkout times vary by hotels. Many hotels provide storage space for guests who need delayed departure time.
10. A 24-hour cancellation policy is observed at all hotels during the entire length of stay.

Thank you for your cooperation. Working together ensures a pleasant stay for your group as well as other hotel guests. Please review these policies with each individual staying in your hotel room. Disturbances will be reported to hotel/motel management and to tournament staff, and may result in individuals being asked to leave without a refund.
